
Action Plans

Disaster Management and Decision Support System (AYDES)

AYDES is a web-based application built on Geographical Information Systems, which can effectively manage all resources in disaster and emergency situations and has decision support mechanisms.

AYDES, which is also the information infrastructure of the **Türkiye Disaster Response Plan (TAMP)**, basically consists of 3 components.

- Incident Command System
- Spatial Information System
- Recovery System



Important:

All the information and data is entered into AYDES during and after a disaster in accordance with the TAMP.



Address Based Population Registration System (ABPRS)

Covering information on usual residence of all people living in the country established in 2007.

Population results refering 31 December based on the new system are announced to the public every year in January. Information provided on :

- Population by localities (province, district, sub-district and village)
- Age and sex,
- Internal migrations,
- Legal marital status,
- Place of registration,
- Educational status,
- Nationality of persons living in Türkiye (Turkish citizens and foreigners)



CRVS data- Death Certificate

International Death Certificate- Formula C

The **death certificate** provides information on the

- identity (TR identity number)
- nationality
- birth date (age)
- sex
- educational status,
- occupation
- residence address of the deceased
- type of death,
- cause of death (ICD-10 codes) etc.

issued in 3 copies for

- certificate of inheritance
- burial
- statistical purposes

Challenges in DRSF Tables C2 & C3

• Many institutions involving in the disaster response

- coordination and collaboration
- scatterred data
- misunderstanding and misuse of common definitions, concepts and terminology

• Catastrophic disasters

- hard to identify deaths or missing people
- hard to pick up dead bodies from the rubble
- hard to coordinate the disaster response activities
- Major / Minor injuries
 - Hard to disaggregate data into major and minor
 - ICD-10/11 codes?
