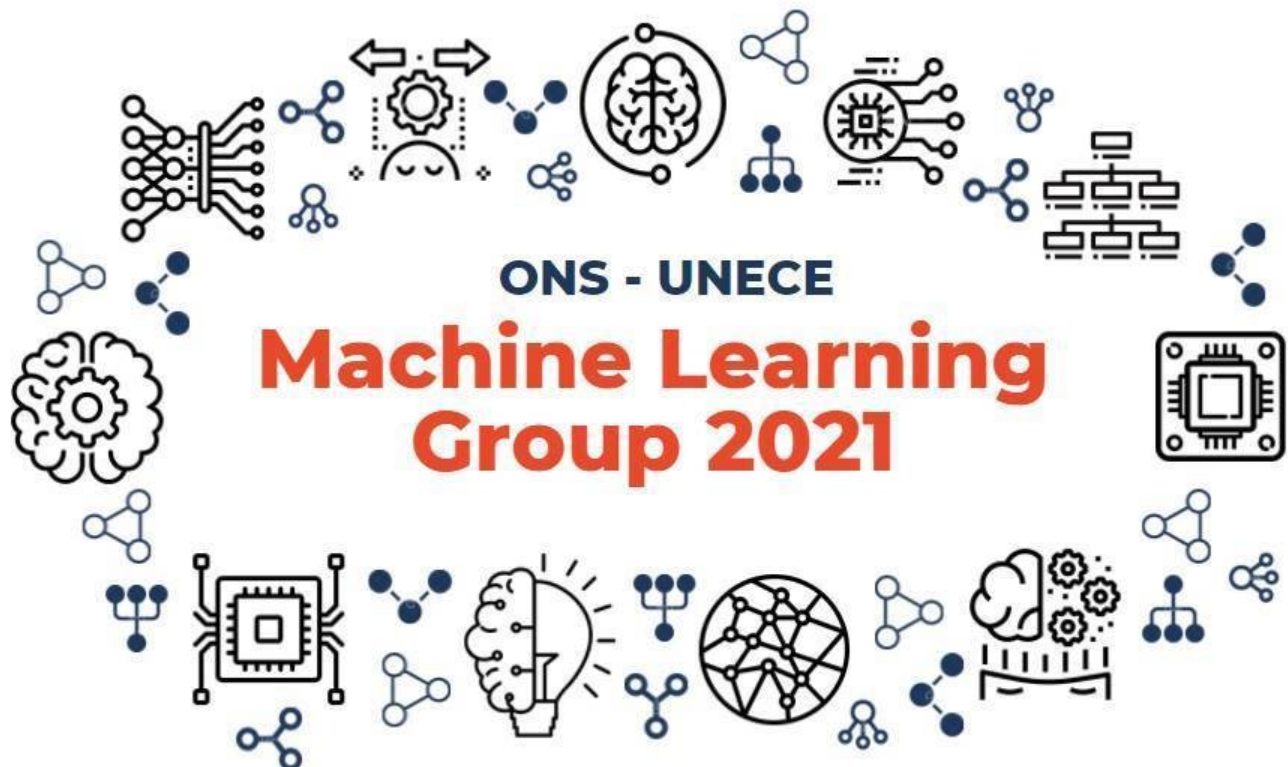


ONS-UNECE Machine Learning Group 2021 Webinar
